The African American Heritage Committee, Inc. extends an invitation to exhibitors and vendors in the areas of African-American food, crafts, art and related artifacts and merchandise. Kuumba Festival organizers retain the right to deny exhibit space to anyone based on inappropriateness of material or theme. This event is family oriented, celebrating African-American contributions to American culture. Entertainment will include gospel, African music, story-telling, fashions and drumming.

Kuumba Festival will be held at Market Park in Laurinburg, NC. This park is located at the corner of Lee's Mill and Produce Market Roads. Market Park is a public park with permanent restroom facilities and covered stage area. Pecan trees provide shade for most of the park. There are a limited number of electrical outlets. Parking is available in a designated section within the park, but away from the booth spaces. No generators will be allowed in booth space in order to keep noise from interfering with entertainment. Vendor's vehicles must be parked in the parking area by 9:30 a.m. Set-up time for vendors is between 7:30-9:30 a.m. and take down is at 4:00 p.m. We ask that vendors stay until the end of the festival. Vehicles will not be allowed in the vending area until the end of festival in order to keep everyone safe. No alcoholic beverages, pets, weapons or raffling allowed on the premises.
